In the present facts and submissions made on behalf of petitioner, the present application is allowed. Let notice of petition be issued to respondents no.9 and 14 through substituted service i.e. by way of publication in newspapers i.e. 'The Statesman' English and 'Navbharat Times' Hindi, having circulation in Delhi, subject to filing of PF and deposit of necessary publication charges for date already fixed in main matter i.e. 13.09.2024.
