ORDER

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1. Petitioners are judgment debtor-1 and judgment debtor-2 respectively and are aggrieved by order dated 23.01.2025 whereby they have been directed to comply with the judgment under execution, within ten working days failing which appropriate action will be taken as per law.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though the judgment debtors have not challenged the judgment and decree in question so far, but

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the judgment is in violation of the settled law and, therefore, is a nullity.

3. It is submitted that, even otherwise, the compliance could have been done by the judgment debtors only if the requisite documents were handed over to them by the concerned Society and Since no such document with respect to *draw of lots* etc. has been given to them, they are not in a position to comply with the directions. It is also submitted that the moment these documents are supplied, they would ensure that the needful is done.
4. Learned counsel for the respondents have appeared on advance notice.
5. Let a short reply/written synopsis be filed by all respondents.
6. The petitioners are also at liberty to file their brief written synopsis.
7. Renotify on 28.07.2025 for further consideration.
8. In the meanwhile, the operation of the impugned order shall remain stayed.
9. Be shown in top 5 matters of advance list.
