ORDER

01.09.2026

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1. During the course of hearing, this Court raised a query as to the documents furnished by respondent nos. 1 and 2 in relation to the regularization of membership. In response, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that *vide* letter dated 27.12.2024, respondent no. 1 had informed the petitioner that the documents sought pertained to a period in respect of which records were stated to be missing, as detailed in FIR No. 548/2023 registered on 06.07.2003 at Police Station – Uttam Nagar, Delhi.

2. Learned counsel further submitted that several communications had



thereafter been addresses to the SHO, Police Station – Uttam Nagar, seeking the documents seized in connection with the aforesaid FIR, however, no response has been received, nor have the requisite documents been furnished till date.

3. On the other hand, Mr. Rakesh Munjal, learned Senior Advocate appearing on behalf of respondent no. 1 draws attention of this Court to the aforementioned letter dated 27.12.2024, and submits that the following documents were re-submitted by respondent no. 1, i.e., (i) Allotment & Possession Letter; (ii) copy of Application dated 12.05.1999 with Affidavit; (iii) Copy of ID card dated 24.07.1995; (iv) Copy of Passport No. A-3721787 dated 18.08.1997; (v) Receipt No. 3352 dated 29.05.1999 for Rs. 110/- and Copy of receipt payment made to Society; (vi) Share Certificate No. 498; (vii) Copy of NOC issued by Administrator cum RO dated 16.03.2021; (viii) NOC dated 25.11.2003; (ix) Details of payment made to Society.

4. In view of the aforesaid submissions, and in order to ascertain the position with regard to the availability and custody of the documents in question, this Court deems it appropriate to issue notice to the SHO, PS – Uttam Nagar, Delhi. The concerned SHO is directed to remain personally present before this Court on the next date of hearing and bring along with him the documents sought by the petitioner.

5. List in the *Supplementary List* on 11.09.2026.

6. In the meanwhile, learned counsel for the petitioner shall be at liberty to coordinate with the SHO, PS – Uttam Nagar, Delhi, and apprise him of the specific list of documents required from the concerned official in the present proceedings.



7. A copy of this order be forwarded to the concerned DCP South-West District, who shall ensure strict compliance with the directions contained herein.
