W.P.(CRL) 1882/2026 & CRL.M.A. 18827/2026 (for interim relief)

1. By way of this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 232/2026 dated 31.03.2026, registered at Police Station Nihal Vihar, Outer District, Delhi, under Sections 115(2)/118(1)/3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, ["BNS"], on the basis of a mutual settlement between the parties.
2. Issue notice. Mr. Anand V. Khatri, learned Additional Standing Counsel, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Mr Nishant, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 2 – complainant.



3. Mr. Khatri submits that, in view of the nature of the injuries, the prosecution has added Section 109 of the BNS. He states that, despite rejection of anticipatory bail applications by the Sessions Court, the petitioners have not joined the investigation and the chargesheet has, therefore, not been filed. In view thereof, Mr. Khatri seeks an opportunity to file a status report.
4. Status report be filed before the next date of hearing.
