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3. This is a writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, 1950, seeking *inter alia* the following reliefs:-

“a. Pass writ, order of Mandamus directing the Respondent to restore the services of the Petitioner and consider the regularization of service of the Petitioner considering his long standing service to the Department in the interest of justice;

b. Pass writ, order of Mandamus directing the



Respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to provide Seniority and all other consequential benefits after regularization of service in the interest of justice.”

4. Issue notice.
5. Notice accepted by Ms. Kaushik, learned counsel for the respondent no.1 and Mr. Satyam, learned counsel appearing for the respondent no.2 who seeks and are granted four weeks to file the counter affidavit with an advance copy to learned counsel for the petitioner. Rejoinder, thereto if any, be filed within four weeks, thereafter, with an advance copy to learned counsel for the respondents.
6. Upon petitioner taking steps within a week, notice be served upon the respondent no. 3 by all permissible modes.
7. Counter affidavit and rejoinder be filed within the same timeline from the date of service.
8. List on 03.09.2024 before the Registrar for completion of service as also pleadings
