1. The present application has been filed on behalf of the appellant under Section 389 read with Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and 430 and 528 of the *Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023*, seeking extension of interim suspension of sentence granted vide order 14.11.2025 which is expiring on 15.12.2025 for a further period of 4 weeks.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has sought the present extension since the surgery of the Petitioner's mother has been done on 08.12.2025 and the doctor has advised constant care and attention to patient and also a

catheter due to the mother suffering from a gynecological problem. The appellant, being the only female member in the family, has sought the extension in order to provide the required care and attention to her mother at such critical time.

3. Previously, the appellant had moved an application seeking extension of interim suspension of sentence which was withdrawn by the appellant on 05.12.2025.

4. Learned APP for State opposes such request for extension, by submitting that the appellant is involved in a heinous case and has been convicted under Sections 302 and 120B IPC.

5. We have heard the learned counsel for the appellant and the learned APP for the State and have perused the record.

6. The interim bail granted to the appellant *vide* order dated 14.11.2025, and which is expiring on 15.12.2025, stands extended, on same terms, for ten days i.e. till 25.12.2025.

7. The appellant will surrender on 25.12.2025 by 5:00 PM.

8. The present application stands disposed of in aforesaid terms.

9. A copy of this Order be sent to learned Trial Court and the Jail Superintendent for information and necessary compliance.
