The petitioner vide the present petition seeks the setting aside of the impugned order dated 07.05.2022 of the Court of the learned ASJ in Bail Appln. 727/2022 qua FIR No.156/2022, Police Station Saket, registered under Sections 420/506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, whereby the respondent No.2 was granted anticipatory bail in the event of arrest subject to terms and conditions as imposed thereby.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that there are observations of the learned Trial Court in the said impugned order to the effect that "Now



whether or not the accused had all the valid licenses / permits for running a restaurant from this leased property is a matter of investigation and trial.”, submitting to the effect that the status report of the State had already been placed before the learned Trial Court and had indicated categorically to the effect that the licences put forth by the accused were not valid. A submission to similar effect is made by the learned APP for the State.

Notice of the petition is issued to and accepted on behalf of the State. The status report qua the investigation conducted be filed by the State. The status report of the State qua the updated investigation be submitted before the next date of hearing.

Notice of the petition be also issued to the respondent No.2 on taking of steps by the petitioner.

The matter be re-notified for 17.10.2022.
