1. Matter is today fixed for admission/denial of documents and marking of exhibits.
2. Counsel for defendant no.1 submits that the defendants have not been given any opportunity to file Additional Affidavit of Admission/Denial of documents qua the documents which were filed by plaintiff alongwith Replication and they be permitted to do so.
3. Counsel for plaintiff submits that Replication was taken on record on 09.10.2025. The parties were directed to file Joint Document Schedule vide order dated 27.11.2025 and therefore, the right of defendants to file Additional Affidavit of Admission/Denial of documents qua the documents which were filed by plaintiff



alongwith Replication stands closed as period of 45 days has already expired.

4. At this stage, a specific query has been put to counsel for plaintiff by this Court as to which Rules of Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018 postulates that the time limit for filing the Additional Affidavit of Admission/Denial of documents qua the additional documents which were filed by plaintiff alongwith Replication is 45 days.
5. In response, counsel for plaintiff reiterated that since no Additional Admission/Denial Affidavit has been filed till date, the additional documents filed by plaintiff are deemed to be admitted.
6. It is a matter of record that plaintiff had filed additional documents alongwith Replication. It is also matter of record that no opportunity was granted to defendants to file Additional Affidavit of Admission/Denial qua the documents filed by plaintiff alongwith Replication.
7. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I am of the considered view that great prejudice will be cause to the defendants if the defendants are not granted an opportunity to file Additional Affidavit of Admission/Denial qua the documents filed by plaintiff alongwith Replication.
8. Hence, the defendants are directed to file Additional Affidavit of Admission/Denial qua the documents filed by plaintiff alongwith Replication within a period of three weeks from today.
9. After filing of same, fresh/revised Joint Document



Schedule (soft copy as well as hard copy) be filed within two weeks.

10. Hard copy of documents which were e-filed be also filed within two weeks thereafter.
11. Re-notify on 19.08.2026 for admission/denial of documents and marking of exhibits.
12. Parties shall appear in person on next date of hearing alongwith Original documents.
