1. *Vide* order dated 08.05.2025, the Parties were referred to Mediation before the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre by recording the statement of the learned Counsel for the Defendant that none of the Defendants have any intentions of using or infringing any of the Marks

2. Pursuant to the said order, the Defendants have filed an Affidavit of Compliance dated 14.05.2025. In this Affidavit, the Defendants have stated as per directions passed in the order dated 08.05.2025, the Defendants have retained the infringing products bearing any of the Trade Marks of the



Plaintiff involved in the present proceedings in their power and possession.

3. The learned Counsel for the Defendants submits that as on date, the Defendants have only 32 infringing products left in their possession and the sale made by the Defendants of 68 products in question were amounting to approximately ₹81,600/- (Rupees Eighty One Thousand Six Hundred Only).

4. The learned Counsel for the Plaintiff submits that let an Affidavit to that effect be filed by the Defendants so that the learned Counsel for the Plaintiff can take instructions with regard to decreeing the Suit in terms of the undertaking given by the Defendants and if the Plaintiff would like to press for any other relief as prayed for in this Suit.

5. Let the said Affidavit be filed within a period of two weeks and let the learned Counsel for the Plaintiff take instructions with regard to further proceedings in this Suit before the next date of hearing.
