1. This is an application filed by the petitioner seeking to place on record additional documents.
2. Taking into account that the writ petition is at a preliminary stage itself as also the fact that these additional documents already form a part of the record of the learned Labour Court, the application is allowed and the documents filed along with the application are taken on record.
3. The application stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.

4. The present petition preferred by the workmen seeks to assail the award dated 24.08.2021 passed by the learned Labour Court. Vide the impugned award, the learned Labour Court has rejected the claim of the petitioners by holding that the petitioners were not able to prove



any employer-employee relationship between the parties.

By drawing my attention to the copies of the attendance register filed by way of additional documents, learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the learned Labour Court has failed to appreciate the effect of these documents which clearly indicate that the petitioner was employed with the respondent since the year 1990.
6. Upon the petitioner taking steps, issue notice to the respondents through all permissible modes.
7. Counter affidavit be filed within six weeks. Rejoinder thereto be filed within four weeks thereafter.
