ORDER

1. The present appeal under Sections 374(2) and 482 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 has been filed against the impugned Judgment dated 14.02.2023 and Order on Sentence dated 03.05.2023 passed by the Additional Special Judge-FTC North, Rohini Court, Delhi in Sessions Case No. 820/2018 arising out of FIR No. 425/2018.
2. The Appellant has been convicted under Section 376(2) and (3) of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ("IPC") and Sections 5(l), (n), (p) and 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.
3. *Vide* the Order on Sentence dated 03.05.2025, the Appellant has been sentenced to life imprisonment along with fine of Rs. 10,000/- for the offence under Section 376(3) of the IPC and in default of payment of fine, he shall undergo simple imprisonment of 15 days.
4. Material on record indicates that the Appellant has undergone



about three years of imprisonment.

5. By the Order on Sentence, the Delhi State Legal Services Authority, North (“**DSL****SA**”) was directed to disburse compensation to the victim, as per rules. It is stated by the learned counsel for the victim that the said compensation has not yet been transferred to the victim.

6. The DSLSA is directed to ensure that the compensation is transferred to the victim within the period of three weeks from today.
