Reply filed by defendants no.1, 2 as well as 3. Rejoinder not filed by the plaintiff. Learned counsel for the plaintiff submits that he does not wish to file rejoinder to reply of defendant no.3. He further submits that he has not received the copy of reply filed by defendants no.1 & 2. Learned counsel for defendants no.1 & 2 undertakes to supply copy of reply to learned counsel for plaintiff during the course of day.

Learned counsel for plaintiff submits that he will file rejoinder to reply filed by defendants no.1 & 2, if required. Rejoinder, if any, be filed positively before the next date of hearing with copy to opposite party.
