ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks, and is granted, a period of *one week* for filing an affidavit in compliance of the last order dated 19.03.2025. Considering the complexity involved as also taking into account the past orders passed by different Courts/ Forums, it is felt appropriate to call upon the parties to file a detailed joint convenience complication.



2. As such, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks, and is granted two weeks for sharing the first draft of joint convenience compilation with the learned counsel for respondent no.1, who, in turn further seeks, and is granted, a period of *two weeks* thereafter to add comments/ documents thereto for circulating/ sharing it further with learned counsel for the respondent no.3 for incorporation of comments/ documents from his end. At the end of it all, learned counsel for the respondent no.3 seeks, and is granted two weeks, to hand over the final copy thereof to the learned counsel for petitioner after incorporating the comments/ documents from his end.

3. As such, the final version of the joint convenience compilation shall be filed by learned counsel for the parties within a period of *ten weeks*.

4. *De hors* the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite specific orders passed from time to time, since the Government of NCT of Delhi is not adhering to the directions given by this Court and there is continuous non-compliance from their end, he shall be moving an appropriate application for impleading the Government of NCT of Delhi.
