I.A. 11983-84/2022 (for exemption)

1. Subject to the plaintiff filing clear and legible copies with proper margins of any document on which the plaintiff may seek to place reliance, within four weeks from today, exemption is granted for the present.
2. The application is disposed of.

I.A. 11987/2022 (u/S 12A of Commercial Courts Act)

3. In view of the urgent relief sought in the present suit, the application is allowed.

CS(OS) 521/2022

4. Let the plaint be registered as a suit.
5. Summons be issued to the defendant through all modes. The summons shall state that the written statement shall be filed by the defendant within thirty days from the date of the receipt of summons. Along with the written statement, the defendant shall also file an affidavit of admission/denial of the documents of the plaintiff, without which the written



statement shall not be taken on record

6. Liberty is given to the plaintiff to file replication, if any, within fifteen days from the receipt of the written statement. Along with the replication filed by the plaintiff, an affidavit of admission/denial of the documents of the defendant, be filed by the plaintiff.

7. The parties shall file all original documents in support of their respective claims along with their respective pleadings. In case parties are placing reliance on a document, which is not in their power and possession, its detail and source shall be mentioned in the list of reliance, which shall be also filed with the pleadings.

8. If any of the parties wish to seek inspection of any documents, the same shall be sought and given within the timelines.

9. List before the Joint Registrar on 12th October, 2022.

10. List before this Court on 17th January, 2023.

11. Issue notice.

12. Notice be issued to the counsel for the defendant.

13. Reply be filed within four weeks.

14. Rejoinder thereto, if any, before the next date of hearing.
