1. Vide order dated 21st January, 2022, this Court had directed the Decree Holder to amend the memo of parties impleading Ms Nidhi Arora as Judgment Debtor no.3.
2. Learned counsel for the Decree Holder states that though the Decree Holder has filed an application in this regard, however, the same is pending before the Registry for the reason in the order dated 21st January, 2022, Ms Nidhi Arora was directed to be impleaded as Judgment Debtor no.3 whereas since the Judgment Debtor no.2, that is, Sachin Chopra, had sold off his



share to Ms Nidhi Arora and is thus not a necessary party. Mr Sachin Chopra is to be deleted from the array of parties and Ms Nidhi Arora is to be impleaded as Judgment Debtor no.2 and thus the previous order of this Court is required to be clarified.

3. Considering the fact that by the application filed, the Decree Holder seeks leave to delete Sachin Chopra as Judgment Debtor no.2 and implead Ms Nidhi Arora as Judgment Debtor no.2, the same be allowed. Ms Seema Chopra, Judgment Debtor no.1 is present in court physically along with her two children Shweta Chopra and Amit Chopra and the learned counsel who appears for Seema Chopra states that she will be also filing her objections as the Decree Holder can claim no share in the property for the reason he deserted Seema Chopra and minor children at that stage and the investment on the property was made by her through her earnings.

4. Ms Shweta Chopra, daughter and Amit Chopra, son of the Decree Holder are also present, who states that they have also filed their objections.
