3. Let copy of the application be given to the learned counsel for the decree holder and other counsels appearing for the parties / objectors during the course of the day. A copy of the objections filed by the objectors be also given to the learned counsel for the decree holder and the counsel appearing for the other parties during the course of the day. Response to the application / objections be filed by the parties within four weeks.

4. I take on record the submission made by Mr. Rawal that the affidavit as directed to be filed on the last date of hearing, shall be filed within one week from today positively. If the affidavit is not filed within a period of one week, the same shall be taken on record, subject to payment of cost of ₹10,000/- to the Delhi High Court Advocate Welfare Society.

5. At this stage, learned counsel appearing for Sachin Chopra makes a request that the Registry be directed to allow him to inspect the Court record. On the counsel following due process, the Registry shall permit the inspection of the Court record by the counsel Mr. Siddharth Mullick. The Registry shall ensure that the vakalatnama of Mr. Siddharth Mullick is on record before the inspection is permitted.
