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1. The Compliance Affidavit, in terms of orders dated 28.01.2025 and 31.01.2025 passed by this Court, has been filed by Respondent No.1.

- 6.1 All judgments sought to be relied upon shall be filed with an index which also sets out the relevant paragraph numbers and the proposition of law that it sets forth.
