1. Respondent No.1 has been served.
2. Mr. Shiv Kumar, Advocate has entered appearance for respondent No.1.
3. Let vakalatnama on behalf of respondent No.1 be filed within two weeks.
4. Service, in terms of order dated 02.08.2023, is complete.
5. Decretal amount has not been deposited.
6. Consequently, para 1 and 2 of order dated 20.11.2023 come into operation, which are reproduced as under:-
