The supervisory jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 227 of the Constitution of India to impugn the order dated 01.03.2024 passed by learned Principal Judge, Family Courts, New Delhi, Patiala House Courts in G.P. No. 9/2023 tiled as “Susheel Kumar Arya vs. Ramanand Rangera” whereby the application moved on behalf of the petitioner under Order VII Rule 11 CPC has been dismissed.
4. Learned counsel submits that at present the custody of both the minor children are with maternal grandparents who are residing in Rajasthan,



therefore, the Family Court at Delhi has no jurisdiction to try the present petition.
