CRL.REV.P.(MAT.) 222/2025

1. This is a criminal revision petition preferred by the petitioner challenging the impugned order dated 02.04.2025 passed by the learned Sessions Court in CA No.194/2024.
2. It is submitted that petitioner filed a complaint case under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 against her in-laws for domestic violence, physical and sexually assault and harassment.
3. It is stated that petitioner inadvertently omitted the names of her brother-in-law and sister-in-law as respondents.
4. The petitioner later sought to amend her complaint to include the said

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family members but her request was turned down by the learned Magistrate vide order dated 15.07.2023. The appeal filed was also dismissed on 02.04.2025, prompting the filing of the present revision petition.

5. Issue notice to the respondents through all prescribed modes, subject to petitioner taking requisite steps, returnable on 17.09.2025.
