The present appeal arises out of the judgment and decree dated 04.09.2020 whereby the suit filed by the Appellant has been dismissed. The transactions between the parties arise out of an alleged loan of Rs.13 Lakhs given by the Appellant herein to the Respondent. The principal contention of the learned counsel for the Appellant is that the Trial Court has itself rendered a finding that the Promissory Note bears the signatures of the defendant thereby implying that the receipt of the loan amount was acknowledged by the Respondent and yet the suit has been dismissed.
