1. There is no appearance on behalf of the Municipal Corporation of Delhi ["MCD"].
2. Mr. Kapil Dutta, learned counsel for MCD, who is present in Court, is requested to take instructions on behalf of MCD or ensure that it is adequately represented on the next date of hearing.
3. At the request of Mr. Pawanjit Singh Bindra, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner, respondent Nos. 6, 7 and 8 [Number Eight Restaurant-cum-Bar, The Masala House, Restaurant-cum-Bar, and Basil and Thyme] are deleted from the array of parties as they are no longer



running in the Sunder Nagar Area. Amended memo of parties be filed within one week.

4. This writ petition has been pending for approximately seven years. The petitioner-Resident Welfare Association [“RWA”] seeks directions for closure or withdrawal of permissions to various restaurants and bars operating in the Sunder Nagar market. MCD is directed to file an updated status report within four weeks with regard to the status of permission, if any, issued to the private respondents, and also to deal with the allegation of encroachment, with regard to prayer (ii) in the writ petition.
