ORDER

1. The petitioner challenges the order passed by the learned Special Judge, whereby the learned Special Judge noting that incorrect particulars had been filed by the petitioner / complainant in regard to the identity of the accused persons passed certain observations against the petitioner corporation.
2. The learned Special Judge also noted that the multiple complaints had been filed by the petitioner / corporation in regard to the electricity theft without putting the correct particulars of the accused persons which had led to the time of the Court being wasted.
3. Considering the nature of the dispute, this Court appointed Mr. Kirtiman Singh, Sr. Adv. as Amicus to assist the Court.



4. After some arguments, the learned Amicus Mr. Kirtiman Singh seeks time to file a report indicating the manner in which the problem as highlighted by the learned Special Judge can appropriately be addressed.
5. Senior officials of the petitioner corporation are directed to cooperate with the learned Amicus in the process.

7. Interim order to continue.
