ORDER

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1. On 12.03.2024, learned ASC had pointed out that notice could not be issued to Respondent No.2 as he was not residing at the address furnished in the memo of parties. This submission was based on the statement of the person residing at the said address, as recorded by the Investigating Officer. Fresh notice was issued to Respondent No. 2 upon the Petitioner furnishing the new address, returnable for 02.05.2024. Matter was adjourned on the said date and is taken up today.

2. Mr. Sandeep Sethi, learned Senior Counsel for the Petitioner, on instructions, states that Petitioner does not have the fresh address of Respondent No.2 and is thus unable to file amended memo of parties.

3. In my view, the only way to serve Respondent No. 2 is through substituted service by publication in two newspapers i.e. The Statesman (English) and Jansatta (Hindi).
