1. Let the plaint be registered as suit.
2. Summons be issued to the defendant by all permissible modes, which shall indicate that the written statements must be filed within thirty days from the date of receipt of the summons.
3. The defendant is directed to file an affidavit of admission/denial against the documents filed by the plaintiff, failing which the written statement shall not be taken on record.
4. The plaintiff is at liberty to file replications thereto within fifteen days of filing of the written statements, which shall be accompanied by affidavits of admission/denial, in respect of the documents filed by the defendants, failing which the replications shall not be taken on record.
5. It is made clear that any unjustified denial of documents may lead to an order of costs against the concerned party.
6. Any party seeking inspection of documents may do so in accordance



with the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.

7. List before the Joint Registrar (Judicial) for completion of pleadings on 13.03.2024.

8. The present application has been filed under Order 39 Rules 1 & 2 read with Section 151 CPC for the grant of ex-parte ad-interim injunction.

9. Issue notice to the defendants through all permissible modes.
