I.A. 1514/2024(for modifications in the Judgement dated 05.01.2024 in I.A. No. 12055/2023)

1. The present application has been filed on behalf of the Defendants for rectification of the typographical error in the Judgement dated 05.01.2024.
2. It is submitted that in Para 2 of the Judgement, it is written that "*After the demise of late Ram Swarup Mehta, his properties devolved upon his wife late Bimla Mehta and thereafter , the properties devolved upon the Plaintiff and Mr. Anil Mehta (defendant no. 1) and Ms. Renu Sood (defendant No.2) in equal share*".



3. In Para 3 it has been written that "*the property no. A-33, Sector 65, Noida, U.P. was the exclusive property of late Smt. Bimla Mehta and Late Sh. Rajeev Mehta*".

3. The following rectifications are made and now the Judgement shall be read as :

PARA 2 : "*After the demise of late Ram Swarup Mehta, who died intestate his properties devolved upon his wife Smt. Bimla Mehta and three children i.e. Smt. Renu Sood , Sh. Anil Mehta and Late Rajeev Mehta as legal heirs in equal share. Smt. Bimla Mehta left behind Wills in r/o her share in various properties in favour of her son Anil Mehta(Defendant No. 1) except for property no. A-705, Anand Dham, Haridwar*".

PARA 3: "*the property no. A-33, Sector 65, Noida, U.P. was the exclusive property of late Smt. Bimla Mehta and Anuradha Mehta*".

4. The present application is accordingly disposed of.
