2. Issue notice.

3. Notice is accepted by Mr. R. Aggarwal, the learned counsel for respondent no.1 and Ms. Ritu Singh Maan, the learned counsel on behalf of the respondent no.2.



4. They point to some glaring inconsistency in the applications filed by the appellant for seeking condonation of delay in filing the appeal as also condonation of delay in re-filing the same.
5. One important aspect would be whether the appellants were in India on 15.04.2025, when the affidavits in support of the appeals are stated to have been attested by the Notary Public.
6. The appellants shall file copies of their passports, within a week from today, as admittedly they are stated to be otherwise residing in the United States of America.
7. In the meantime, the respondents may file their formal response to these applications. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within a week thereafter.
