ORDER

% **28.03.2025**

1. Vide order dated 10.03.2025, the Hon'ble Court has, *inter alia*, passed the following order:-

“(i) 50% of the enhanced compensation shall be released to Respondent No.1 on furnishing an indemnity bond with an undertaking by way of an affidavit. The affidavit shall set out that in the event the Appellant succeeds in the present Appeal, Respondent No.1 shall repatriate the compensation so released back to the Appellant.

(ii) The remaining 50% of the compensation shall be released to Respondent No.1 on furnishing of adequate security to the satisfaction of the worthy Registrar General of this Court.

(iii) The interest, which is accrued on the amounts deposited, shall also be released in the same proportion.”

2. In compliance of the aforesaid order of the Hon'ble Court Indemnity Bond alongwith undertaking by way of an affidavit have been filed by the respondent No.1/Chander Pratap Singh in original today in the court for the purposes of releasing of 50% of the enhanced compensation amount lying deposited in this case alongwith proportionate accrued interest.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent No.1 submits that the respondent No.1 shall be bound by the orders of the Hon'ble Court and in the event the appellant succeeds in the present appeal, the respondent No.1 shall re-deposit



the amount so released to him. It is further submitted by the learned counsel that the respondent No.1, who is present in the court today is also ready to give his statement in this Court to this effect apart from filing his Indemnity Bond and undertaking by way of an affidavit.

4. Statement of the respondent No.1 qua furnishing his indemnity bond and undertaking by way of an affidavit regarding re-deposition of the released amount in terms of any future directions of the Hon'ble Court has been recorded separately and he has also been identified by his counsel.

5. In view of the indemnity bond and the undertaking by way of an affidavit filed by the respondent No.1 in terms of the aforesaid order of the Hon'ble Court and also keeping in mind the statement given by him qua re-depositing the amount on any future directions of the Hon'ble Court or in the event of the appellant succeeding in the present appeal, I find no impediment in releasing the 50% of the enhanced compensation amount lying deposited in this court, to respondent No.1 alongwith the proportionate interest against his aforesaid indemnity bond and undertaking by way of an affidavit filed on record.

6. Registrar (B&A) is directed to remit the 50% of the enhanced compensation amount lying deposited in this court alongwith proportionate accrued interest on the same directly to the bank account of respondent No.1, the details of which is given in his statement, in terms of the order dated 10.03.2025 passed by the Hon'ble Court after due verification.
