4. I am informed by Mr. Manish Gandhi, who appears for the appellant, that the appellant has deposited Rs. 5, 00,000/- with the Registry of this Court.

4.1 The statement of Mr. Gandhi is taken on record.

4.2. Mr. Gandhi says that since the appellant has deposited the said amount, as directed by this Court, *vide* order dated 11.11.2020, stay on the execution proceedings be made absolute during the pendency of the appeal.

4.3. Mr. Chadha says that he would have no objection if such a direction is passed by the Court.

4.4. It is ordered accordingly.
