ORDER

30.11.2022

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1. As per order dated 17th August, 2022, a direction was given for a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- to be deposited in the bank account of the respondent within six weeks. Today, the learned counsel for the respondent states that even though the amount was deposited in two installments of Rs.2,00,000/- and Rs.3,00,000/- respectively. However, that money has been received from third parties and not the petitioner. The counsel for the petitioner states that he has filed an affidavit before this Court. He has borrowed this money and, therefore, it was necessitated to be paid through the third parties. Be that as it may, the petitioner should file affidavits from the said third parties alongwith identification proof or presence in the Court or through VC for this Court to verify the same before the next date of hearing. As regards the direction by this Court of maintenance @ 25,000/- per month, the counsel for the respondent states that only Rs.50,000/- has been received



for three months. However, the counsel for the petitioner refutes the same and an amount of Rs.75,000/- was paid. Before the next date of hearing, compliance affidavit be placed by the learned counsel for the petitioner. It is made clear that there should be no violation of the orders passed by this Court.
