ORDER

1. This is a petition under Section 528 BNSS, filed on behalf of the petitioners, seeking quashing of FIR No. 1/2024, PS EOW as also the charge sheet and the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.
2. Learned Senior Counsel, appearing for the petitioners, invites the attention of the Court to the order dated 24.07.2024, passed by the predecessor Bench of this Court in a petition under Section 482 Cr. PC, filed by the second wife of the deceased Faiz Murtaza Ali, whereby, the trial court proceedings have been stayed.
3. Learned Senior Counsel submits that FIR has been registered on the basis of a complaint filed the mother, first wife and the daughter from the first wife of late Faiz Murtaza Ali, filed before the EOW Cell, alleging that

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the alleged Will of late Faiz Murtaza Ali and the Nikahnama of marriage of Faiz Murtaza Ali with Rohini Wahi @ Ruhani were forged documents. He states that petitioner No. 1 is an Advocate, who had drafted the alleged Will while petitioner No. 2 is one of the four witnesses of the Nikahnama and that they acted only under instructions.

4. Issue notice.
5. Notice accepted by the learned APP, appearing for the State and by the learned counsels appearing for respondents No. 2 & 3.
6. Reply/Status Report be filed within four weeks.
7. Renotify on 23.07.2025 with Crl. M.C. No. 4606/2024.
8. In the meanwhile, proceedings before the trial court qua the present petitioners shall remain stayed.
