1. Counsel for the parties submit that these applications have become infructuous and can be disposed of.

2. Accordingly, applications are disposed as infructuous.

I.A. 2439/2025 (under Order XV-A Rule 6(1)(c))

3. This application has been filed on behalf of the plaintiff under Order XV-A Rule 6(1)(c) of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 ('CPC') seeking an extension of time for compliance with case management directions, issued on 5th September, 2024.

4. *Vide* the order 5th September, 2024, the plaintiff was directed to file its



affidavits in evidence within six (6) weeks. It is stated that the affidavits of evidence could not be filed on behalf of the plaintiff within the stipulated time due to the highly technical nature of the suit patent.

5. Issue notice.

6. Notice accepted on behalf of the defendants.

7. Ms. Vibha Dutt Makhija, Senior Counsel appearing on behalf of the defendants opposes the extension. She submits that there is a partial interim injunction order against the defendants and prolonging the trial in the matter will prejudice the defendants.

8. Having heard the counsel for the parties, I am inclined to grant four weeks' time to the plaintiff, as a last opportunity, to file the affidavits in evidence of all the plaintiff's witnesses.

8.1. The same shall be filed on or before 28th February, 2025.

9. The application stands disposed of.

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10. The Local Commissioner has already been appointed for recording of evidence in the suit. The Local Commissioner is requested to expeditiously record evidence in this case.

11. Last opportunity is given to the plaintiff to take instructions *vis-à-vis* the security to be furnished as noted in paragraph 29 of the order dated 4th August, 2023.
