1. Petitioner seeks stay of the proceedings. She submits that the earlier suit filed by them before the Jamnagar Court has already been decreed.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in that particular suit *M/s Tirupati Metals* were given conditional leave to defend, and since the condition was not complied, a decree has been passed against them.
3. Learned counsel for the respondent/plaintiff herein, does admit that the plaintiff has suffered a decree but at the same time, she submits that they have already challenged the decree by filing a *Regular First*



Appeal.

4. Let short reply be filed with respect to the main petition by the respondent/plaintiff within four weeks from today with advance copy to opposite side.

8. Parties are directed to appear before the *Delhi High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre* on 14.07.2025 at 3:00 pm.
9. Let the outcome be awaited for 18.08.2025.
10. Be shown in supplementary list.
11. The next date of hearing i.e. 10.10.2025 stands cancelled.
12. The learned Trial Court is also requested to defer the recording of the evidence till next date of hearing.
