ORDER

07.02.2025

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1. The grievance of the Petitioners, as articulated in the present Petition, is that Respondent No.1 had refused to issue a Health Insurance policy to their minor son, on the ground that the disability of their son would not be covered by their underwriting policy.
2. Learned Counsel for the Respondent No.1 submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court on 25.01.2023, certain directions and changes have been taken place by the Respondent No.1/company and the Petitioners are now free to obtain Health Insurance Policy in satisfaction of their grievance in the present Petition from an Insurance Company of their



choice, including Respondent No.1. Learned Counsel for the Respondent No.1 thus submits that the grievance of the Petitioner in the present Petition stands satisfied.

3. The parties seek and are granted time to file their short note of contentions in the matter, not exceeding three pages each, at least one week before the next date of hearing, along with the compilation of judgments, if any, they wish to rely upon. All judgments sought to be relied upon shall be filed with an index which also sets out the relevant paragraph numbers and the proposition of law that it sets forth.
