I.A. 2024/2025 (Application for condonation of 6 days delay in re-filing I.A. 2023/2025)

1. For the reasons stated in the said application, the same is allowed.
2. The delay of 6 days in re-filing the application is condoned.
3. Application stands disposed of, accordingly.

I.A. 2023/2025 (Application under Order VI Rule 17 of CPC for amendment of plaint)

1. The application under Order VI Rule 17 of CPC, has been filed by the plaintiff for amendment of the plaint. The plaint had been filed on the basis that *Late Princess Pratap Kumari* was unmarried and, therefore, intestate succession was claimed in favour of the plaintiffs, who are siblings, nieces



and nephews of *Late Princess Pratap Kumari*.

2. It is now stated that the plaintiffs have come to know that *Late Princess Pratap Kumari* was actually married in the year 1955 to *Late Shri Digvijay Singh* of *Wankaner*. However, the marriage was sought to be annulled at the behest of *Late Shri Digvijay Singh*, on the account that the marriage could not be consummated.

3. There is an agreement executed on 15th October, 1958 with the intent to nullify the marriage which was superseded by agreement dated 24th February 1960.

4. To provide complete clarity and place all the facts on record, this application has been allowed.

5. Accordingly, issue notice to the defendants to be served through the counsel for the defendants through all permissible modes.

6. List before the Joint Registrar (Judicial) on 04th April 2025, the date already fixed.
