1. This petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of order dated 01st April 2025 passed by the Division Bench of this Court in **MAT. APP. (F.C) 210/2024**. Relevant directions passed by the Court are extracted as under:



5. In the meantime, as an *interim* direction, the learned counsels for the parties agree that the respondent shall allow the appellant and the minor son of the parties, visitation with the minor daughter on every 4th Saturday of the month, between 03:00 PM to 08:00 PM, at a place mutually decided by the learned counsels for the parties in consultation with each other. The respondent shall drop off the child at the said place in the custody of the appellant at 03:00 PM, and shall take the custody of the child from the appellant at 08:00 PM from the same place. During the visitation, the appellant shall be free to interact with the child, and the respondent shall remain absent at the time of such interaction and visitation.

2. Counsel for petitioner states that the visitation on 26th April 2025 was impeded by respondent by holding the hand of the daughter all throughout the visitation and showed deliberate non-compliance of directions passed by this Court.

3. There are other circumstances, in previous situations which have been narrated in the said petition.

4. Accordingly, issue notice to the respondent on steps being taken by petitioner through all permissible modes including email, returnable on 23rd September 2025.

5. If respondent refuses to comply with the orders of this Court, appropriate strictures shall be passed against the respondent.

6. Order be uploaded on the website of this Court.
