CS(COMM) 437/2024

1. The Settlement Agreement dated 17.04.2025 arrived *inter se* the plaintiff and the defendant nos.2, 4, 5, 13, 14 and 15 before the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre (DHCMCC) is on record. Learned counsel for the parties involved pray for decree of the present suit in view of the terms contained therein qua the defendant nos.2, 4, 5, 13, 14 and 15.
2. Learned counsel of the plaintiff and the defendant nos.2, 4, 5, 13, 14



and 15 confirm the terms of the Settlement Agreement dated 17.04.2025 and identify the signatures of their respective clients.

3. This Court has perused the terms of the Settlement Agreement dated 17.04.2025 as recorded *inter se* the plaintiff and the defendant nos.2, 4, 5, 13, 14 and 15 and finds them to be lawful.

4. In light of the above, the present suit is decreed in terms of the settlement between the plaintiff and the defendant nos.2, 4, 5, 13, 14 and 15 as recorded in the Settlement Agreement dated 17.04.2025.

5. Needless to mention, the plaintiff and the defendant nos.2, 4, 5, 13, 14 and 15 shall remain bound by the terms of settlement as recorded in the aforesaid Settlement Agreement dated 17.04.2025.

6. Registry is directed to draw up the decree sheet accordingly.

7. Needless to mention, the Settlement Agreement dated 17.04.2025, shall form part of the Decree Sheet.

8. Renotify on 18.07.2025.

9. In view of the Settlement Agreement *inter se* the plaintiff and the defendant nos.2, 4, 5, 13, 14 and 15, the present application has become infructuous.

10. In view thereof, learned counsel for the plaintiff wishes to withdraw the present application.

11. Accordingly, the present application is dismissed as withdrawn.

12. In view of the settlement agreement *inter se* the plaintiff and



defendant nos.2, 4, 5, 13, 14 and 15, the present applications are surviving against the remaining defendant nos.1, 3, 6 to 8 and 10 to 12.

14. In view of the aforesaid developments, learned counsel for the plaintiff submits that she does not wish to press the present application.

15. The present application is accordingly dismissed as not pressed.

16. Learned counsel for the defendant no.1 seeks, and is granted, four weeks to come prepared with appropriate instructions *qua* the present application.

18. Learned counsel for the defendant nos.3, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11 and 12 seeks, and is granted, four weeks for filing an affidavit containing the details of the steps initiated/ taken by them along with relevant photograph(s) in compliance with order dated 01.10.2024 (*para 9*).

19. At this stage, learned counsel for parties seek, and are granted, four weeks for filing their written synopsis not exceeding five pages, giving a chronological list of dates and events and relevant documents, if any, along with duly highlighted judgments setting out the propositions of law therein, they wish to rely upon.

20. Accordingly, renotify on 18.07.2025.
