1. The learned counsel for the defendant, on instructions from the defendant, who is also present in Court, submits that without admitting any of the contents of the application, in any case, as the tenancy already stands extended till October 2024 in favour of the tenant, who was already in occupation of the subject-property, the present application has been rendered infructuous.
2. In that view, as the application has been rendered infructuous, the same is disposed of as such.

3. The learned counsel for the defendant submits that, without admitting



any of the contents of the application and without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the defendant, in case the plaintiff is to produce the original diary for the inspection of the defendant, the defendant can admit or deny the said document on such production.

4. In that view, before proceeding to consider this application on merit, it is felt appropriate that the plaintiff shall produce the original diary for the inspection of the defendant, on which the defendant shall carry out the admission/denial.

5. The plaintiff shall place on record the photocopy of the diary in question.

6. For this purpose, list before the learned Joint Registrar (Judicial) on 13th December, 2022.

7. On completion of such admission/denial, the learned Joint Registrar (Judicial) shall place the matter before this Court.
