1. After some arguments, learned counsels appearing on behalf of the parties are *ad idem* that plaintiff need not file the original family settlement dated 21.07.1998 and she can produce the same and have it exhibited, if permitted under law, at the time of her examination/cross-examination.
2. In the event such original family settlement dated 21.07.1998 is produced by the plaintiff, learned counsel for the defendant shall be at liberty to take objection with regard to the said document being unregistered/unstamped and shall be at liberty to pray to the learned Joint Registrar for impounding the same.
3. In the event such an objection is taken, the learned Joint Registrar will decide the same in accordance with law.
4. In view of the above clarification, place the matter before the learned Joint Registrar for further proceedings on 16.07.2026, for the purpose it is already listed.
