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I.A. No. 25679/2025 seeking condonation of delay of 12 days in filing the reply to defendant no. 1's application under order XXXIX Rule 4 along with supporting affidavit.

1. Issue notice. Notice accepted by ld. Counsel for defendant no. 1. Ld. Counsel for defendant no. 1 submits that he has no objection if the application is allowed.
2. For the reasons stated in the application, application is allowed. Delay stands condoned. Reply to IA No. 22192/2025 is taken on record. IA stands **disposed off**.

3. Reply has been filed on behalf of the plaintiffs. Ld.



Counsel for defendant no. 1 submits that rejoinder is in the process of being filed as per rules. Put up again for completion of pleadings.

I.A. No. 22192/2025 (under Order XXXIX Rule 4 r/w Section 151 CPC on behalf of defendant no. 1 for vacation of the exparte ad interim injunction order dated 27.05.2024)

4. Reply on behalf of the plaintiff has been taken on record today after condoning the delay. Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff is directed to re-file the reply for formally placing it on record. Rejoinder, if any, be filed as per the timeline already indicated, as worked out from today. Put up for completion of pleadings.

5. Reply on behalf of defendant no. 1 has still not been filed. Ld. Counsel for defendant no. 1 submits that they are in the process of filing a reply, as per rules. Put up again for completion of pleadings.

I.A. No. 21865/2025 on behalf of defendant no. 1 seeking interrogatories upon the plaintiffs.

6. This application has been kept pending for the reason that defendant no. 1 had to move an application for seeking exemption in filing supporting apostilled / legal affidavits. The said application was subsequently allowed by the Hon'ble Court and ld. counsel was allowed two weeks to file the apostilled / legal affidavits alongwith the Board Resolution. The said filings are however under objections since advance service of the same has not been done to ld. Counsel for the plaintiff.
