**I.A. 20460/2025 (FOR CONDONATION OF 21 DAYS' DELAY IN
REFILING REPLICATION)**

1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The averments made in the application would indicate that the replication to the written statement filed by defendant nos. 1 and 2 was filed on 21.07.2025, thereafter, on 22.07.2025, the Registry raised certain objections concerning the replication of the plaintiff.
3. The replication was re-filed on 19.08.2025 after removing all the objections. The objections were to be removed within 7 days and in aggregate within 30 days.



4. Under the aforesaid circumstances, since the delay of 21 days has occurred in re-filing the replication, therefore, this application has been filed for condonation of such delay.

5. The application is strongly opposed by Mr. Singhal, learned counsel for who appears for one of the defendants. He contends that under the aforesaid circumstances, the Court may consider to impose cost on the plaintiff.

6. Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, the Court finds that the plaintiff seems to be a senior citizen over 82 years old. The plaintiff has stated that he was in the process of tracing of certain documents which has resulted in causing the delay.

7. Accordingly, keeping in mind the peculiar circumstances, the Court finds that the delay has been properly explained. Accordingly, in the interest of justice, the delay in re-filing the replication is condoned.

8. The instant application stands disposed of.
