1. This is a writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for seeking to quash Order NO. F.18/346/2014/HG/37-38 dated 03.01.2025 passed by the respondent whereby the request for release on parole of petitioner has been rejected mainly on the ground that he had jumped the furlough of three weeks granted to him previously and was re-arrested after more than 4 years and 8 months.

2. Issue notice. Notice is accepted by Ld. ASC on behalf of the State,



who submits that petitioner had earlier filed a similar petition before another bench which was later withdrawn. He further states that the address given in the nominal roll of the petitioner is incorrect. However, the Ld. Counsel appearing for the petitioner states that the address given in the memo of parties is the correct address of the petitioner.

3. Let the same be verified and the report in this regard be filed before the next date of hearing.
4. Meanwhile, updated nominal roll of petitioner be requisitioned from the concerned jail superintendent.
