1. Both these petitions assail same order. It appears that the learned trial magistrate dismissed the interim maintenance application of wife on the ground of her qualifications and capability to earn. But the appellate court set aside that order and remanded the matter to the trial court. Thereafter, the



trial court fixed interim maintenance at the rate of Rs.18,000/- per month with effect from the date of the application. But the appellate court modified that order and directed the interim maintenance to be paid from the date of order. Hence, the husband claims that nothing is payable to the wife while the wife claims that the interim maintenance should be from the date of application.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel that trial court record would be required to be referred to but the same has not been summoned.
3. Digitized record of the trial court be requisitioned within four weeks.
