1. The present application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner seeking directions to the respondents to install an electric pole, near temple, Vasundhra Enclave, Delhi, in terms of order dated 22nd September, 2025.
2. It is submitted that *vide* order dated 22nd September, 2025, this Court



had directed the petitioner to move an appropriate representation to the electricity department for installation of electric pole near the temple.

3. It is submitted that the petitioner made a representation dated 27th September, 2025 to BSES Yamuna Power Ltd., requesting to immediately re-install the electric pole with electricity connection near the temple. However, the BSES Yamuna Power Ltd. declined to entertain the representation on the ground that the electric pole has to be erected by the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (“MCD”) and only then BSES will give electricity connection to the pole.

4. It is submitted that the petitioner approached the MCD officials and apprised this fact, however, MCD has refused to do the needful.

5. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner further submits that barricading by the police near the temple premises should be there throughout the year, in order to safeguard the sanctity of the place.

6. Issue notice. Notice is accepted by learned counsels appearing for respondent nos. 1, 5 & 6.

7. Issue notice to respondent nos. 2 to 4 by all modes, upon filing of Process Fee.

8. Let replies be filed by the respondents, within a period of four weeks, from today.

9. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within a period of two weeks, thereafter.

10. Re-notify on 20th March, 2026.
