ORDER

1. The learned senior counsel for petitioner has referred to order dated 04.12.2019 whereby the investigation for the offence under Section 420/406 IPC was stayed. He submits respondent No.2 was a dealer of petitioner and there was an outstanding due against respondent No.2 to the tune of Rs.89.00 Lacs. The respondent No.2 even sent email dated 30.03.2015 whereby he admitted he would make payments in terms as stated therein.
2. The dealership of respondent No.2 was withdrawn on 23.06.2015 and thereafter on 25.08.2015 a civil suit for recovery of Rs.89.00 Lacs was filed against respondent No.2 wherein the respondent No.2 filed the written statement without any counter claim *qua* the losses allegedly suffered by him.
3. Since both - the petitioner and respondent No.2 has worked together



for some time, they may be given a chance to settle the matter amicably.
