Pitampura and property bearing No.2047-P, Sector 9

- (5) *Whether the plaintiffs are entitled to rendition of accounts as prayed for in prayer clause 'B' of the plaint? **OPP***
- (6) *Whether the plaintiffs are entitled to decree for permanent injunction as prayed for in prayer clause 'C' of the plaint? **OPP***
- (7) *Reliefs, if any."*
