1. The present petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (CrPC) for quashing of the FIR No. 240/2017 dated 15.05.2017, registered at Police Station Nihal Vihar, for offences under Sections 323/341/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC') and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
2. The chargesheet has been filed under Sections 323/341/506/34 of the IPC.
3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the parties have settled their disputes.
4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State opposes the quashing on the ground of settlement. He submits that the serious allegations were made by the complaint, who alleged that the Petitioner No. 1 despite being married had got

married to the complainant. He submits that the allegations have also been made that the Petitioner No. 1 and other family member had beaten the complainant.

5. The complainant is present in the Court and states that she does not wish to pursue any proceedings arising out of the present FIR.

6. Let the status report be filed before the next date of hearing.

7. The learned Trial Court is directed not to proceed with the proceedings arising out of the FIR No.240/2017 till the next date of hearing.
