2. This petition has been filed by the petitioner, challenging the Order dated 04.02.2025 passed by the learned Central Administration Tribunal Principal Bench, New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as 'Tribunal') in O.A. No. 1112/2024, titled ***Lalit vs. Union of India & Ors.***, whereby the said O.A. filed by the respondent no.1 herein was allowed. The learned Tribunal directed the petitioners herein to treat the Experience Certificate subsequently submitted by the respondent no.1 as valid, and to further consider the candidature of the respondent



no.1, if otherwise found eligible, for the post of Lab Attendant in terms of the Selection List dated 29.12.2023, within a period of six weeks.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that not only the second certificate produced by the respondent no.1 was after the cut-off date, but there are also reasons to doubt its authenticity. Moreover, the laboratory from which the certificate was obtained by the respondent no.1 is neither approved nor recognized by the Central/State Government.

4. Issue notice

5. Notice is accepted by Mr. Piyush Beriwal, the learned counsel for the respondent no.2.

6. Let notice be issued to the respondent no.1 to be served through all permissible modes, returnable on 13th October, 2025.

7. Let a counter affidavit be filed within a period of six weeks from today. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within a period of three weeks thereafter.

8. In the meantime, there shall be a stay on the enforcement of the Impugned Order.
