1. The Petitioner has approached this Court with the following prayers:

“(a) Issue a writ of mandamus or any other writ, order, or direction to the Respondents No.1 to 3 to accept the application of the Petitioner dated 15.05.2024 for renewal of its swimming pool license and continue to renew the same every time till the disposal of W.P.(C) No. 6463 of 2017 titled C J International Hotels Ltd. Vs. New Delhi Municipal Council (the only pre-condition being health license);

(b) Issue a writ of mandamus or any other writ, order,



or direction to the Respondents to renew the Swimming Pool License of the Petitioner No. 1 consistent with the law without the requirement/ stipulation of Health Trade License and in terms of Judgment dated 19.10.2023 and 28.03.2024 r/w 24.04.2024 and without insisting on the Health Trade License in view of the orders passed;

(c) Issue appropriate writ or direction commanding Respondent No. 4 to inspect the swimming pool at the Hotel of the Petitioner No. 1 at Le Meridien, 8, Windsor Pl, Janpath, Windsor Place, New Delhi – 110001 and submit a report to the Respondents No. 1 to 3 with a copy to the Petitioner No. 1.

(d) Issue a writ of certiorari or any other writ, order or direction setting aside / quashing the communication dated 16.05.2024 issued by the Respondent No. 2;

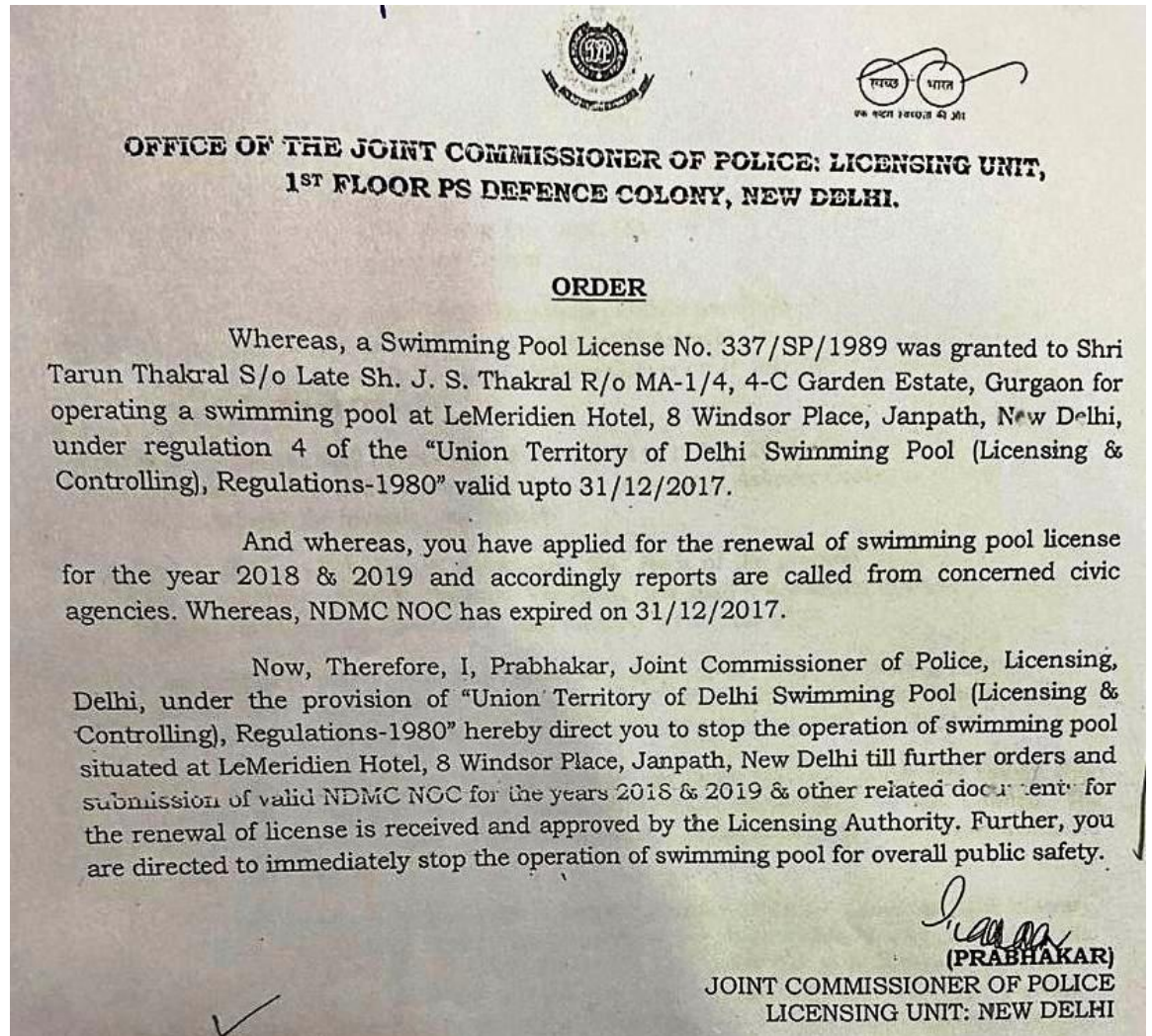
(e) Issue a writ of mandamus or any other writ, order or direction directing the Respondents No. 1 to 3 to continue renewing the Eating House, Lodging and swimming pool licenses of the Petitioner No.1, till the disposal of the Writ Petition being W.P.(C) No. 6463 of 2017 and the orders passed therein;

(f) Issue a writ of prohibition restraining the Respondents from taking any adverse, coercive, or punitive action whatsoever and in any manner against the Petitioner, its agents, employees, etc., or which interferes with the normal course of functioning of the swimming pool of the Petitioner's Hotel during the pendency of the instant writ petition, and/ or interfering with the functioning of the same.
