As per office note, one Certificate with title as Certificate under Section 2A of Banker Books Act, 1891 filed by HDFC Bank Ltd. is on record. However, the said Certificate does not fully comply Section 2A of Banker Books Act, 1891. Learned counsel for HDFC Bank Ltd. seeks some more time to file the proper Certificate. The same is strongly opposed by learned counsel for the petitioner, who submits that it is intentionally done by HDFC Bank Ltd. only to delay the present petition filed by the petitioner. Despite repeated opportunities, the proper requisite Certificate is not being filed by HDFC Bank Ltd. No plausible explanation is furnished for the same. It has led to delay in disposal of the present matter. So, cost of Rs.10,000/- is imposed upon HDFC Bank Ltd. to be deposited with Delhi High Court Legal Services



Committee and the last and final opportunity is granted to HDFC Bank Ltd. to file requisite Certificate within ten days with copy to learned counsel for the petitioner.

At request, the HDFC Bank Ltd. is also directed to supply copy of Certificate filed today to learned counsel for the petitioner within one week through email.

Re-notify the matter for further proceedings on 01.09.2025.
